

VOTING BY CITIZENS WHO HAVE NEVER LIVED IN THE UNITED STATES

DELAWARE	A US Citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register and vote in the county where a parent would be eligible to register and vote (for Federal offices only).
GEORGIA	If a US citizen outside of the US has never lived in the US and either parent is a qualified Georgia voter then, he or she is eligible to register and vote where his or her parent is a qualified voter.
HAWAII	US citizens who have never resided in the US but have a parent who is eligible to vote in Hawaii are eligible to vote at the same voting residence claimed by their parent (for local, state and Federal office ballots).
IOWA	If a US citizen outside the US has never lived in the US and either parent is a qualified Iowa voter then, that person is eligible to register and vote where his or her parent is a qualified voter.
MASSACHUSETTS	US citizens who have never resided in the US but have a parent who is eligible to vote in Massachusetts are eligible to vote at the same voting residence claimed by their parent (for local, state and Federal office ballots).
NEW YORK	A US Citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register and vote in the country where a parent would be eligible to register and vote (for Federal offices only).
OKLAHOMA	If a US citizen outside the US has never lived in the US and either parent is a qualified Oklahoma voter then, he or she is eligible to register and vote where his or her parent is a qualified voter.
OREGON	A US citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register temporarily and vote in the county where a parent would be eligible to temporarily register and vote pursuant to this action.
RHODE ISLAND	If the person is a US Citizen and has never lived in the US but has a parent who is a qualified Rhode Island elector then, this person will be eligible to register and vote in Federal elections.
TENNESSEE	A US citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register temporarily and vote in the county where a parent would be eligible to temporarily register and vote pursuant to this action.
WEST VIRGINIA	A US citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register and vote in the county where either parent would be eligible to register and vote.
WISCONSIN	A US Citizen who was born abroad and who is eligible to vote and who has never lived in the US may register and vote in the country where a parent would be eligible to register and vote (for Federal offices only).
